

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

**THE CITY OF LA CAÑADA FLINTRIDGE (CITY) IS SOLICITING BID PROPOSALS FROM QUALIFIED
CONTRACTORS FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECT:**

**INVESTIGATION AND IDENTIFICATION OF
SEWER LATERAL AT 5134 ANGELES CREST HIGHWAY
CONTRACT 20/21-3**

RECEIPT OF BID PROPOSALS. Sealed bid proposals must be addressed to the City Clerk and mailed or delivered to the Department of Public Works at the City Hall, One Civic Center Drive, La Cañada Flintridge, California 91011-2137, until **2:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 8, 2020**. The envelope shall be marked in the upper left-hand corner with the name and address of the bidder and the Project name "Investigation and Identification of sewer lateral at 5134 Angeles Crest Highway.

AB44 EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014. If a bidder submits a bid that includes a subcontractor who would be performing work in amount in excess of ½ of 1% of the bidder's total bid or in the case of bids for the construction of streets or highways, including bridges, in excess of ½ of 1% of the bidder's total bid or \$10,000, whichever is less, then in addition to the subcontractor's name and business address, the subcontractor's State contractor's license number must be included as part of the information submitted for that proposed subcontractor. Failure to provide the subcontractor's license number shall render the bid non-responsive.

SB854 EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2015. Contractors and Subcontractors wishing to work on a public works project must be registered with the State of California, Department of Industrial Relations. All public works projects with bids submitted after March 1, 2015, or awarded on or after April 1, 2015, shall use only registered contractors and subcontractors.

If awarded a contract, the Bidder and its subcontractors of every tier shall maintain active registration with the Department of Industrial Relations for the duration of the Project.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS. All bidders shall be licensed in accordance with provisions of the Business and Professions Code and shall possess a State Contractor's license, **Class A**, at the time of bid submittal. The successful Contractor and his subcontractors will be required to possess business licenses from the City.

ADDENDA. Addenda, if any, will NOT be mailed out to any of the plan holders and will ONLY be posted on the City website at: <https://cityoflcf.org/>. **It shall be the Bidder's responsibility to check the City website for any addenda.**

OPENING OF BID PROPOSALS. The bids will be publicly opened and read **at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday October 8, 2020** at the said City Hall, and the results will thereafter be referred to the City Council for consideration at a subsequent meeting.

PRE-BID MEETING. There is no pre-bid meeting for this project.

SCOPE OF WORK. The work to be done consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals as required by the Plans and Contract Documents. The general items of work includes; obtain double Caltrans " rider" permit; set up traffic control per approved plans; sawcut 6'x6' and remove asphalt; excavate to locate the chimney per as-built plan; perform shoring and bracing to secure excavated hole; perform CCTV inspection with sewer lateral launcher and identify the alignment of the lost lateral . Backfill the trench with one sack cement slurry, grind and install steel plate recessed in pavement flush with existing surface. Restore the pavement with asphalt plus 1" of existing thickness of asphalt. In case of the sewer lateral is found to be short of reaching to property line, the contractor will extend the lateral to the property line. Clean up and leave in an operable and acceptable condition all of the work.

COMPLETION OF WORK. The work shall commence within fifteen (15) calendar day after the date set forth in the "Notice to Proceed." **All Base Bid work shall be completed in its entirety within fifteen (15) working days from said date.**

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. Plans and Specifications will be made available on the City website at: <https://cityoflcf.org/publicworks/projects-out-to-bid/#cips> for electronic download at no cost. Bidders are required to submit a request using the form on the website for the Plans and Specifications, after which the name of the bidder will be added to the Plan holders List. Only registered plan holders will be allowed to submit a bid proposal. The Notice Inviting Bids and the Plan holders List will also be posted on the City website.

QUERIES/ADDENDA. All queries related to the Project shall be submitted electronically using the form posted on the City website. All Addenda, if any, will ONLY be posted on the City website. It shall be the Bidder's responsibility to check the City website for any addenda.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS. The Contractor's attention is directed to Appendices "B" and "C" for compliance. A minimum of fifty percent (50%) of the project's waste **including soil/dirt** is required to be recycled or reused. Prior to the start of work, the Contractor shall submit a performance security, calculated as the lesser of three percent (3%) of the project bid or \$10,000 in a form acceptable to the City. Such performance security shall be forfeited to the City if the recycling requirements are not satisfied. Prior to the start of work, the Contractor shall obtain written authorization from the Engineer for the

following: (i) proposed haul route (see Appendix "E") and (ii) any proposed self-hauling of materials. Any monitoring of the self-hauling deemed necessary by the Engineer shall be at the sole expense (deposit may be required) of the Contractor.

GUARANTEE. Each bid shall be made on the proposal form furnished by the City and shall be in accordance with the Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bidder's bond, payable to the City in a sum not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the contract for the work, the full amount of such guarantee to be forfeited to the City should said bidder fail to enter into said Contract. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Faithful Performance Bond in the amount of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, and a Labor and Material Bond in an amount of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, said bonds to be underwritten by sureties qualified to do business in the State of California, carrying a rating of A+ or better, in the current edition of Bests Insurance Guide.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST. In the procurement of supplies, equipment, construction, and services by sub-recipients, the conflict of interest provisions in 24 CFR 85.36, OMB Circular A-110, and 24 CFR 570.611 shall apply. No employee, officer, or agent of the sub-recipient shall participate in the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported by federal funds if a conflict of interest, real or apparent, would be involved.

PREVAILING WAGES. Any contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Pursuant to the provisions of the California Labor Code Section 1773.2, the minimum prevailing rate of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract shall be those determined by the Director of Industrial Relations of the State of California, which are on file in the Public Works Department at City Hall and are available to any interested party on request.

LABOR CODE CONCERNING APPRENTICES. Attention is directed to the provisions of Sections 1777.5 and 1777.6 of the Labor Code, concerning the employment of apprentices by the Contractor or any subcontractor under him. The Contractor and any subcontractor under him shall comply with the requirements of said sections in the employment of apprentices. It shall be the Bidder's sole responsibility to evaluate and include the cost of complying with all labor compliance requirements.

Information relative to apprenticeship standards and administration of the apprenticeship program may be obtained from the Director of Industrial Relations, San Francisco, California, or the Division of Apprenticeship Standards and its branch offices.

PAYMENT RETENTION. The Contractor may elect to receive 100 percent of the payments due under the contract without retention of any portion of the payment by the City, by depositing securities of equivalent value with the City in accordance with the provisions of Section 4590 of the Government Code. Said securities if deposited by the Contractor shall be valued by the City whose decision shall be final.

CITY'S RIGHTS RESERVED. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in a bid, and to make awards in the interest of the City. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the bid opening.
