

City of La Cañada Flintridge Foothill Boulevard at Daleridge Road Traffic Signal Warrant Study Notice of Community Meeting March 16, 2023

The City of La Cañada Flintridge has prepared a Traffic Warrant Study at the intersection of Foothill Boulevard and Daleridge Road. The City proposes to construct a traffic signal including an advanced warning system for westbound traffic, upgrade intersection safety lighting, and upgrade the existing pedestrian crossing just west of Foothill Blvd at Daleridge Road. The existing pedestrian crossing will be incorporated into the new traffic signal.

The City invites you to participate in a Community Meeting to present a conceptual plan of the proposed traffic signal, discuss the next steps and answer questions regarding the project. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, March 16, 2023**, at **6:00pm** in the City Council Chambers located at City Hall, One Civic Center Drive.



- The satisfaction of a traffic signal warrant or warrants shall not in itself require the installation of a traffic control signal.




Foothill Blvd at Daleridge Rd Conceptual Plan


























































