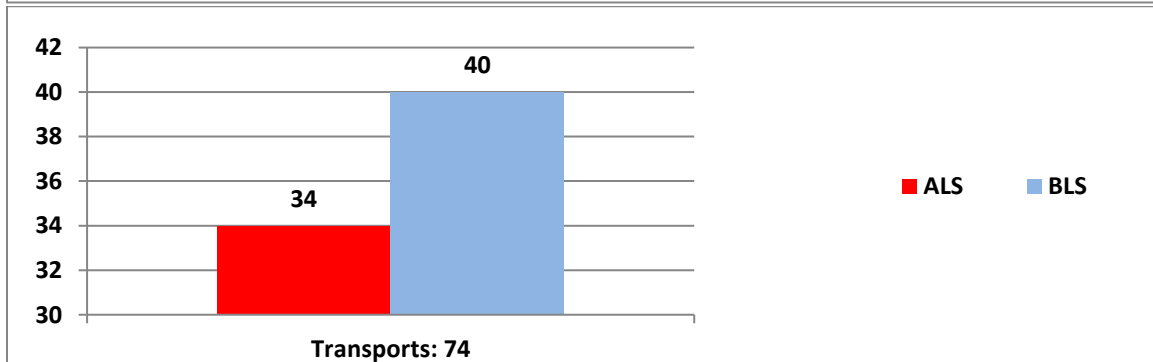
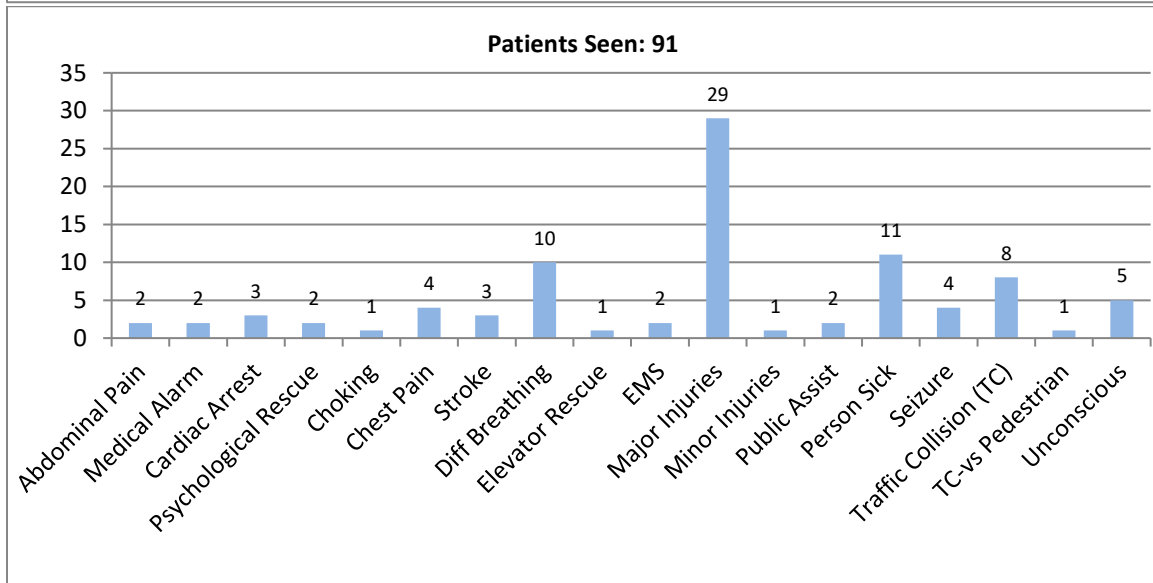
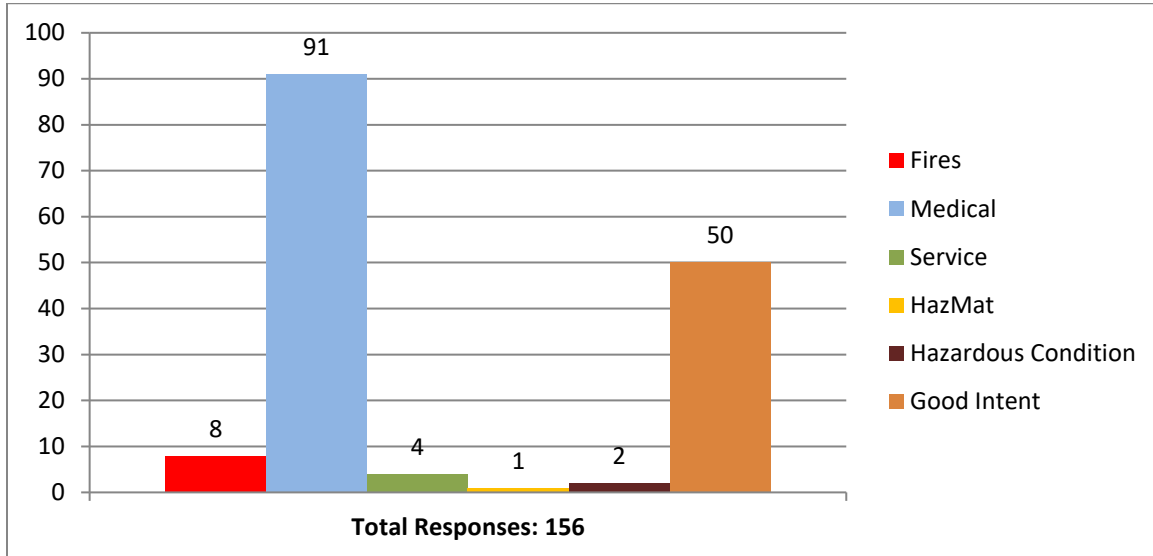

- Keep a fire extinguisher handy.

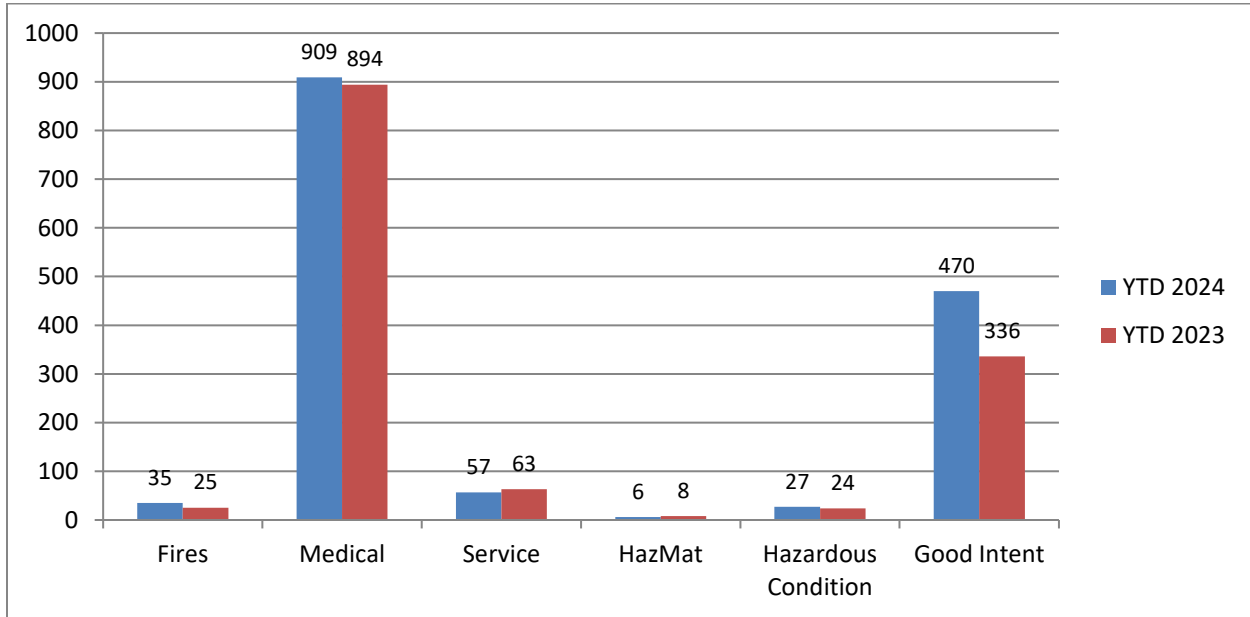
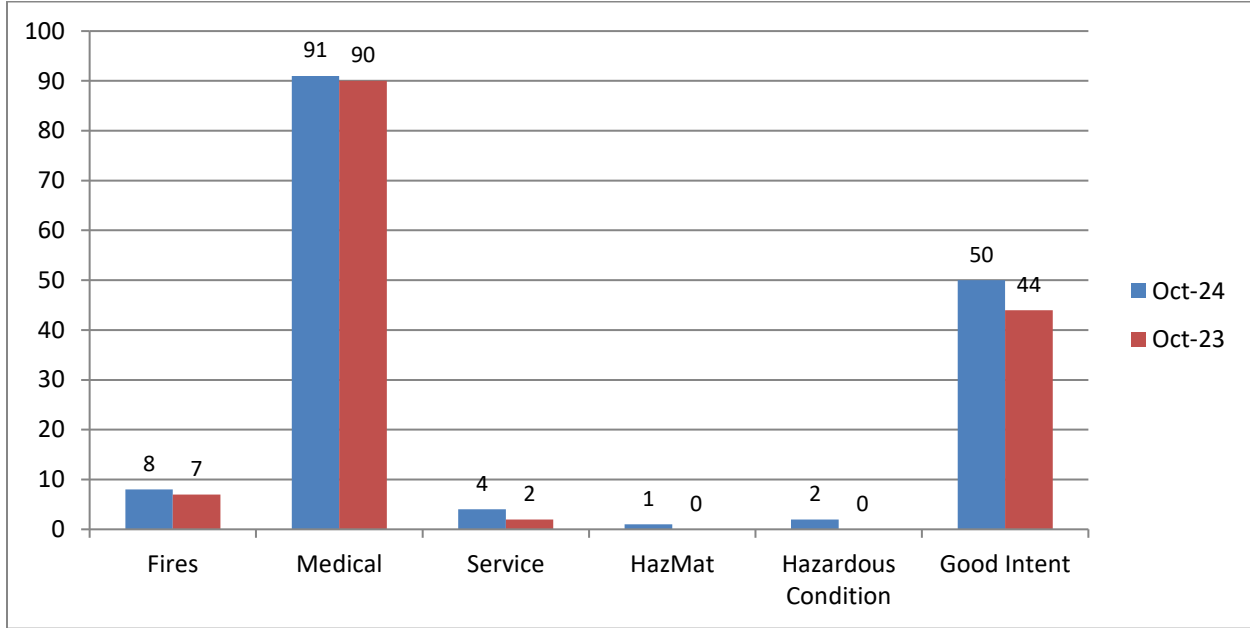
